

In reference to a DM-CI-2019-00-062 dated March 18, 2019 saledted teachers will be asked to participate in a survey which will gather data to inform the modification and enhancement of the Bilingual Education and the MTBMLE policies.


The following guidelines are set for the survey:

1. The stratified random sampling technique shall be employed to meet the required number and to avoid choosing respondents coming from one school or area only. In divisions where all school sizes are present (small, medium, large, very large), the number of required respondents will be divided by four (4). Here is a sample breakdown for Albay which requires 96 K to 3 teachers and 96 Grades 4-6 teachers.


