



SUBJECT : **ADVISORY ON THE CONTINUATION OF MEASLES OUTBREAK
VACCINATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED
IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM**

DATE : June 2, 2019

1. In line with the Department of Health: Measles Elimination and Control Measures, Program, the second dose of measles vaccines will be administered to all learners from Kindergarten to Grade 7. Likewise, as the regular SBIP will be implemented for School Year 2019-2020, the continuation of measles outbreak vaccination will be conducted in June to September 2019.
2. **Target population**
All learners from Kindergarten to Grade 7 for the School Year 2019-2020 with Zero (0) or one (1) dose.
3. **Advocacy and distribution and retrieval of informed consent form**
Teachers and school clinic staff must inform the learners and their parents about the school based immunization in school; and will distribute and retrieve Informed Consent forms for measles vaccine and tetanus-diphtheria vaccination prior to schools scheduled immunization dates.
4. **Screening of Immunization status**
Teachers and school clinic staff shall conduct screening for learners for their Immunization status starting June, 2019. This can be done by checking the students Immunization card or the school health record



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5. Masterlisting

Teachers and school clinic staff shall accomplish the Master List of eligible learners for vaccination. All learners with zero (0) or one (1) dose of measles vaccine immunization history will be included in the masterlist of learners to be vaccinated on the scheduled dates of vaccination provided by the City/Rural Health Unit.

6. Implementation

All grade 1 and 7 learners will receive 1 dose of tetanus-diphtheria vaccine regardless of immunization status. A separate Masterlist form for Grades 1 and 7 will be provided.
