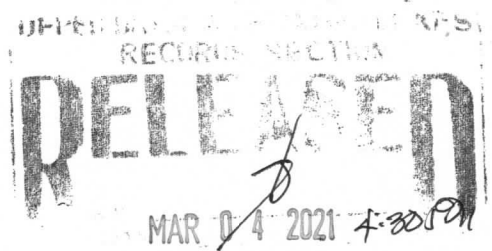



**DIVISION ORIENTATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES OF RESULTS-BASED
PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum DM –PHROD -2021-0010 dated January 11, 2021 titled: *Guidelines on the Implementation of the Results- Based Performance Management System for SY 2021*, the Schools Division Office through the Human Resource and Development unit shall conduct a Division Orientation on the modified RPMS SY 2020-2021.
2. The two-day activity aims to:
 - a. orient the raters on the phases of RPMS cycle and the implementation guidelines for SY 2020-2021;
 - b. review the RPMS indicators based on the PPSST priority indicators and the different means of verification;
 - c. show example of portfolio of a proficient and highly proficient teachers and;
 - d. submit action plan for RPMS orientation in the districts/schools.
3. Target participants are Public Schools District Supervisors, Secondary School Heads and Master Teachers of Elementary and Secondary Schools.
4. Target dates are as follows:
March 10-11, 2021 – (PSDSs and Elementary Master Teachers)
March 12-13, 2021 – (Secondary School Heads and Master Teachers)
5. Venue is to be announced later through an advisory. A one-day (1) service credit/ COC shall be given to participants who will attend on March 13, 2021.
