- In preparation for the forthcoming 6th Bicol Patiribayan Festival, the **2016 Division Patiribayan Festival in Araling Panlipunan** with the theme "**Continuing Investment on the Youth: Opportunities to address Issues on Population, environment and Resources**" will be held on December 2, 2016 at Division Office Hall A . The Festival covers the following On-the-Spot Skills Exhibitions:
 - Elementary Level
 - Essay Writing
 - Poster Making
 - Secondary Level
 - Pop Quiz
 - Essay Writing
 - Jingle Writing and Singing
 - Poster Making
- The Festival aims to provide opportunities for students and teachers to showcase their talents through exhibition of their products and performances as evidence of their learning.
- There will be one (1) contestant per district for every event for elementary and secondary, except the Pop Quiz which is open to all secondary schools.
- It is expected that a District Elimination Contest shall be conducted to select the division contestant both in elementary and secondary level.
- The First Place winners in the secondary level shall represent the division in the 6th Bicol Patiribayan Festival in Araling Panlipunan on December 8, 2016 at RELC Hall, Rawis, Legaspi City.
- Enclosed are the schedule of activities, specific guidelines for each skill exhibition and working committees.
- Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against school's MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Specific Guidelines for the 2016 Division Population Quiz and On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition

Theme: "Continuing Investment on the Youth: Opportunities to address Issues on Population, environment and Resources"

General Guideline: Participation is open to students in Elementary, Junior High School or Senior High School currently enrolled in public or private secondary schools for S.Y. 2016-2017

A. Pop Quiz

1. The formulation of test questions at the division level shall be based on the following Education Core Messages/Key Concepts:

- Family Life and Responsible Parenthood
- Gender and Development
- Population and Reproductive Health
- Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development

2. The following are the suggested review materials for POP QUIZ provided by the PopCom. These can be surfed from the internet:

- YAFS 2013
- State of World Population Report 2013
- State of World Population Report 2011
- Learning Package on Parent Education for Adolescent Health and Youth Development Modules 3 and 5
- MDG Report 2012-2013 from UN-ESCAP
- Philippine Population Management Program Directional Plan 2011-2016
- Philippine Health Survey 2011

- During the quiz, participants will be provided with pens and writing sheets that are numbered and color-coded. The monitor will collect the writing sheets after each round.
- English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
☑ Participants will be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy," seven (7) are "average," and seven (7) are "difficult."
- Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:
 - ✓ One (1) point for each "easy" question
 - ✓ Two (2) points for each "average" question
 - ✓ Three (3) points for each "difficult" question

- Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. For questions that require computation, participants shall be given a maximum of thirty (30) seconds.
- The quiz master will only read each question twice. Count down will start after the question has been read the second time.
- Should a participant wish to change an answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with one horizontal line. The new answer must be written clearly above the crossed out answer. A participant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
- A division winner will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring.
- All ties shall be broken by a tiebreaker question from the "difficult" category.
- In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:
 - ✓ Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
 - ✓ The protest or inquiry will be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges who will recognize the protest or inquiry.
 - ✓ The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.

On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition

(Time limit for each on the spot contest is 60 minutes)

The theme of the showcase will be announced on the actual day of the skills exhibition.

Essay Writing

1. The essay shall be written in English
2. The participants shall use black or blue pens only.
3. The essay shall be at least 800 but not more than 1000 words. This should be legibly written in double space in the provided writing pad. Essay must be original and previously unpublished.
4. The theme or topic shall be given during the contest. Contestants shall provide their own title.
5. The contest shall last for one (1) hour. There shall be no extension of time for late comers.
6. Criteria for judging shall be based on the following:

Presentation and Style -----	40%
Form, Content and Insight -----	60%
Accuracy -----	20%
Fairness (balanced, sound) -----	20%
Methodology -----	20%
TOTAL -----	100%
7. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable.

Poster Making

1. Each district should be represented by one (1) contestant only.
2. Pre-drawn sketches shall not be allowed.
3. Each contestant should bring ¼ size illustration board and craypass as materials. Only color Red, Blue, Yellow and a limit of three (3) colors plus black and white shall be allowed. Only five (5) colors shall be allowed to be placed on the working tables of each contestant. Combination of these colors shall be allowed.
4. Borrowing of materials from the contestants during the contest shall not be allowed.
5. Duration of the contest shall be 60 minutes. There shall be no extension of time for the late comers.
6. Finished outputs should not contain any label of the theme.
7. Criteria for judging are as follows:

Creativity and Presentation -----	50%
Originality -----	30%
Relevance to the theme -----	20%
TOTAL -----	100%

8. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable

Jingle Writing and Singing

1. Each district should be represented by one (1) contestant only.
2. Contestant shall be given one (1) hour to compose an original composition in English based on the theme which shall be announced on the actual day of the event.
3. Compositions shall be collected after an hour right after the jingle composition.
4. Presentation should be in 2 to 3 minutes only right after the jingle composition.
5. Contestant are not required to bring any musical instruments because presentation will be in acapella.
6. Criteria for judging are:

Lyrics -----	50%
(Relevance to the theme)	
Musicality -----	30%
(Execution/over-all performance)	
Originality -----	20%
(Creativity)	
TOTAL -----	100%

7. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable.
