Subject: **PROVINCIAL ORIENTATION – CONFERENCE AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL CAREER ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION (NCAE) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2017 – 2018**

Date: August 25, 2017

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016 entitled Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program, DepEd Order No. 25, s. 2017 entitled School Calendar for School Year 2017 – 2018 and DepEd Memorandum No. 140, S. 2017 entitled Administration of the National Career Assessment Examination for School Year 2017 – 2018, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), shall administer the National Career Assessment Examination (NCAE) for the School Year 2017 – 2018 from August 30 to 31, 2017 (Wednesday and Thursday) to all Grade 9 students in both public and private schools nationwide.
2. Each NCAE examinee shall be issued a Certificate of Rating (COR) that contains the obtained test scores in the domains and level of preferences in the occupational fields.
3. All NCAE takers shall be ready with the following:
 - a) Region Code
 - b) Division Code
 - c) School ID
 - d) LRN
 - e) Copy of their Final ratings in all subjects in Grade 8 for Grade 9 takers and in Grade 9 for Grade 10 takers. (NOTE: Grade 10 takers who failed to take the March 1 and 2, 2017 NCAE)
 - f) Lead pencil #2 (at least 2), sharpener and eraser.

4. A Provincial Orientation Conference on the NCAE Administration will be on August 26, 2017 (Saturday). 8:00 o'clock in the morning at Catanduanes National High School (ICT Room). Since August 26 falls on a Saturday. A one (1) day service credit and compensatory overtime credit shall be given to the participants as provided in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits.
5. All Secondary School Heads are advised to conduct school level orientation prior to the test administration.
6. Authorized to attend the Orientation Conference are the Chiefs, EPSs, PSDSs, and Heads of Public and Private Secondary Schools. The School Testing Coordinator shall represent the School Head in their absence.
7. For confidentiality and security of the test materials, School Heads are enjoined to get the NCAE materials on August 29, 2017 and shall return the same on September 1, 2017. Schools near the Division Office are advised to return the Test materials immediately after the administration of the test. Confidentiality and security of the materials are under the care of the Secondary School Heads.
8. The CID and SGOD Chiefs together with the Education Program Supervisors and the Public Schools District Supervisors shall supervise and monitor the activity in their respective areas of supervision.
9. Attached is the List of Chief Examiners, Room Supervisors, and Room Examiners on the conduct of NCAE. They are enjoined to report to their respective assigned schools on or before 7:00 o'clock in the morning of August 30 and 31, 2017.
10. Travel and other incidental expenses to be incurred relative to this activity are chargeable against local / school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) with the assistance of schools division and secondary schools personnel, shall administer the **National Career Assessment Examination (NCAE) for the School Year (SY) 2017-2018** from August 30 to 31, 2017 to all Grade 9 students in both public and private schools nationwide. This is pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016 entitled *Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program* and DO No. 25, s. 2017 entitled *School Calendar for School Year 2017-2018*.
2. The authorized forwarder shall deliver the test materials to schools divisions outside the National Capital Region (NCR) two weeks before the test administration. The same forwarder shall retrieve the test materials one week after the test administration.
