- 1. In line with the Department of Education's thrust to enhance instructional delivery in Kindergarten, SDO Catanduanes thru the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a 3-day Division Training Workshop for LAC Leaders in Kindergarten on Development, Revision, and Finalization of the ADM Modules for Kindergarten (Series 1). This initiative aims to strengthen the capacity of Kindergarten LAC Leaders and refine the ADM modules to ensure high-quality learning resources for kindergarten learners.

 - c. Finalize the ADM modules in alignment with the revised Kindergarten Curriculum and contextualized learning approaches.
- 3. The listed participants attached in this memorandum (see Enclosure No. 1) are advised to bring relevant materials such as copies of revised kindergarten learning competencies, kindergarten competency framework, laptops, reference materials, and other necessary resources.
- 4. School heads must ensure that the class of identified teachers are properly managed and taken care of. However, if the teacher's absence will adversely affect student learning, please notify the Office of the SDS immediately so that a replacement can be arranged.
- 5. For services rendered on holidays and Saturdays, participants are entitled of Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit pursuant to DO No. 53, s. 2023- Updated guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 3, s, 2004- Non-Monetary Compensation for Overtime Services Rendered.
- 6. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred in attending this activity shall be charged to local funds or other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
