END-OF-SCHOOL-YEAR (EOSY) RITES THEME FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

1. In accordance with DepEd Memorandum No. 27, s. 2025, and Division Memorandum No. 246, s. 2025, the End-of-School-Year Rites for Kindergarten, Grade 6, Grade 10, Grade 12, and Alternative Learning System (ALS) learners who have successfully completed the basic requirements of the Basic Education Curriculum shall be conducted from April 14-15, 2025

2. The theme for the School Year 2024-2025 End-of-School-Year (EOSY) Rites shall be "**Henerasyon ng Pagkakaisa: Kaagapay sa Bagong Pilipinas**" (**Generation of Unity: Partners for the New Philippines**). This theme highlights the significance of this generation's unity as a driving force for national solidarity, emphasizing the need to transcend differences and work toward common goals. 
