- 4. Each school is advised to prepare and bring a copy of list of participants, signed individually of the teacher/learner attendee to be submitted to the training facilitators before the delegation will be admitted to the Science-on-the-Move Traveling Exhibit. Each batch is composed of 150 learner-attendee/teacher will be accomodated in the exhibit for 1 and a half hours and a total of 6 batches per day to start at 7:30 am and end at 12:00 noon for the morning batches and to start again at 12:30 pm and end up at 5:00 pm for the afternoon session.
- 5. No registration fee will be collected from the participants. Entrance fees of participants will be shouldered by the Philippine Foundation for Science and Technology. Travel allowance and other expenses of the participants relative to their attendance to the said activity are chargeable against MOOE/Local Funds and/or other fund sources subject to the usal accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
