DIVISION MATERIALS DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH TEACHERS

- 1. In line with the division's senior high school implementation with the target to prepare materials both for the English teachers and learners use, there will be a DIVISION MATERIALS DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH TEACHERS on **November 28-30**, **2019** in a venue to be announced later.
- The training -workshop aims to :
- 1. Enhance teachers knowledge on learning competencies (LCs) for senior high school English subjects.

- 3. Capacitate English teachers in preparation for the school-based learning action cell (SLAC) for senior high English teachers, both for the major and non-majors.
- 3. Participants to this activity is ONE English major-representative from each 42 secondary schools and additional one from the Catanduanes National High School, Pandan School of Arts and Trade, and San Andres Vocational School.
- 4. Trainers/facilitators are requested to report at the Curriculum Implementation Division on **November 22, 2019** at 8:00 in the morning for the Division Staff Orientation Workshop.
- 5. This is a live-out activity, meals for snacks and lunch for three days is charged to the HRTD CID funds in English while travel and other operating expenses is charged to the school's MOOE subject to the accounting rules and regulations.
