## FIRST INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ASEAN EDUCATION AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE

Schools Division Superintendents To: All Others Concerned

- Pursuant to DepEd Advisory No. 029, s. 2018, the Department of Education, through 1. the Regional Office V- Division of Naga, will conduct the First International Conference on ASEAN Education and Cultural Exchange with the theme: One Culture, One Identity, One Community form March 26-28, 2018 at The Tent, Avenue, Plaza Hotel, Naga City.
- The conference aims to:
  - a. intensify awareness and understanding of young people on ASEAN integration;
  - b. capacitate direction of ASEAN students and educators through cultural presentations and performances;
  - c. establish a pool and bonded community of student-leaders and educators who continuously champion ASEAN; and
  - d. increase engagement of ASEAN students, educators and other stakeholders to help build the region's external political, economic, social and cultural community.
- The target participants are delegates from the ten ASEAN member states, educational 4. institutions and agencies in the Philippines, students, and teachers who will showcase their own regional cultural practices through dances, songs, chants, and other performances.
- Participants of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-5. classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
- A registration fee of Php6,500 per participant (inclusive of seminar kits and meals), 6. exclusive of accommodation shall be chargeable against Division/ Local Fund/ Special Education Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Early registrants will only charge Php5,999 on or before March 15, 2018.

- 7. Payment should be made through Ms. Marites Sta. Maria-Mendoza of SHM Consultancy Management as agreed in the Memorandum of Agreement between DepEd Naga City Division and SHM Consultancy.
- 8. Mesis (AM Snacks, Lunch and PM Snacks) will start on Day 1, March 26, 2018 and last meal will be lunch of Day 3- March 28, 2018. However, onsite registration will be accommodated on Day 0-March 25, 2018.
