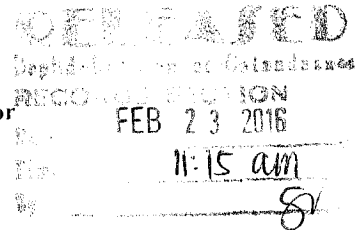

1st Alternative Learning System (ALS) Division Encampment for
Out-of-School Youths and Adults

1. The Alternative Learning System (ALS), DepEd Division of Catanduanes will hold the 1st Alternative Learning System (ALS) Division Encampment for Out-of-School Youths and Adults on April 7 – 9, 2016 at Virac Sports Complex, Virac, Catanduanes with the theme: “**Ang Liwanag at Sigla ng ALS ay Ramdam sa K to 12**”.

2. This Division encampment aims to:

- a. Equip the OSY with life skills (LS) and lifelong learning (LL) necessary to become effective, efficient and responsive citizens.
- b. Strengthen the OSY/OSA spiritual and moral values.
- c. Develop self-reliant, dynamic and creative leaders to become effective catalysts/ agents of change.

3. Participants in this Division Encampment are Out-of-School Youths and Adults enrolled in any ALS learning programs. A minimum of ten (10) participants per District is expected to attend. However, district/s may opt to send more than the minimum number of participants subject to availability of funds.

4. District ALS Coordinators, Mobile Teachers, Barangay Literacy Volunteers are expected to attend.

5. Interested stakeholders are encouraged to participate in the said activity, provided they are endorsed by their respective heads of organizations.

6. The participants are expected to bring the following:

a. Individual

- Personal belongings, toiletries
- Sweater, jacket, rubber shoes, slippers
- Flashlight, medicines
- Casual wear

7. There shall be no registration fee. Travel and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged to LGU/SEF/GAD funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Cost of materials during the activity shall be charged to Division funds.

8. Program of Activities, Camp Layout, Camp Staff & Working Committees, and Guidelines for Campers are found in the attached enclosures.

9. Winners of the academic and skills contest will represent the Division to the Regional OSY Encampment. Coaches shall review the contestants to prepare them to these activities.

10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is earnestly desired.

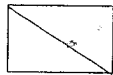

GUIDELINES FOR CAMPERS

1. Each adult camper must have a copy of the Division Memorandum No. __, s. 2016 entitled 1st Alternative Learning System (ALS) Division Encampment for Out-of-School Youths and Adults. The encampment is for OSY's age 15 and above. Adult campers will just provide assistance and support.
2. Refer to the working committees in the memoranda for your assigned tasks. Proper coordination is very necessary.
3. Each OSY will bring his own plate, glass, cup, spoon, fork, pail and dipper in addition to what to bring individually which is stipulated in Division Memorandum No. __, s. 2016. The district delegates shall provide themselves with the following:
 - pop tent
 - fly tent for cooking & dining area
 - water container
 - cooking & eating utensils
 - compass
 - charcoal/LPG gas stove
 - patrol flag pole- 7 feet tall
4. Registration of campers will start on April 7, 2016 1:00 pm, hence, DALSC or any member of the registration committee shall coordinate with the Division registration committee by following the registration procedure.
5. Every registered OSY participant should attend all camp activities such as base instruction, academic contest, Lear – A – Trade & ALSlympics etc. which are reflected in the activity card. Hence, the adult leaders in-charge of the contest should be familiarized with the guidelines and assist the contestants.
6. It is suggested that District Delegation may have the tent pitching on April 7, 2016.
7. Each zone should wear a neckerchief as an identifying mark to be provided by the camper himself with half of a meter but in triangle form for his/her scarf. Tetoron cloth is suggested. One meter can provide 2 participants.

8. There are six (6) academic contest events which will be simultaneously conducted: Poster Making, Slogan Making, Essay Writing, Spelling Bee, ALS & Math Quiz and Anagram. Hence, please identify 1 contestant per event to which your delegates will join.
 9. Winners of the academic contest will automatically represent the division in the 13th Regional ALS OSY/As Summer Encampment at Masbate Province Division on April 21 – 25, 2016.
