Subject: 2016 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Week Celebration

Date: July 7, 2016

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 74, s. 2016 and DepEd Memorandum No. 90, s. 2016, the Department of Education, Division of Catanduanes will celebrate the 2016 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week dubbed as 38<sup>th</sup> National Disability Prevention Rehabilitation Week from July 17-23, 2016 with the theme "Kapanatagan ng May Kapanatagan, Isakatuparan.... Now Na"! The theme focuses on the realization of the fundamental freedom and rights of persons with disabilities as provided for in existing international mandates and laws.
2. The celebration aims to stimulate public awareness on the issues and problems of disability. Hence, everyone is encouraged to take an active role in the upliftment of the economic and social conditions of persons with disabilities (PWD's) in the country.
3. The schools can select appropriate school activities which can be conducted at the school and/ or district levels. The SPED center, schools with SPED programs are encouraged to undertake the activities relevant to this year's Celebration. However, all activities to be undertaken should not disrupt classes nor compromise their supervision pursuant to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
4. In addition, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Region V in coordination with the Department of Education will conduct the Forum on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management/Climate Change Adaptation (DRRM/CCA) cum Regional Poster Making Contest for Children with Special Needs (Hearing Impaired, Grades IV-VI) on July 27, 2016 at La Plaza Hotel, Tahao Road, Legazpi City.
5. Entry forms for the poster making contest should be submitted on or before July 11, 2016 (please see guidelines for details).
6. All schools with SPED program are enjoined to include poster making contest (deaf and hearing impaired Grade IV-VI) in the school based activities. However, due to time constraint, a division level competition could not be conducted, instead, the student-contestant and coach for the Poster Making Contest of JMAMES SPED Center will represent the division in the regional competition.

**MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES**

**I. Introduction**

Science and Technology (S&T) Disaster Mitigation and Preparedness is one of the Eight Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Outcomes under the Millennium Development Goals (MDG) in 2000-2015. With the new set of sustainable Development Goals (SDG) composed of seventeen (17) thematic areas, Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM)/Climate Change Adaptation (CCA) has been prioritized for 2016-2020.

Project NOAH (Nationwide Operational Assessment of Hazards), DOST's popular tagline is its response to the call of President Benigno S. Aquino III for more accurate, integrated and responsive DRRM/CCA. Through the concerted efforts of government warning agencies, Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) and the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS), DOST leads the National/Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (N/RDRRMC) for its thematic area on Disaster Prevention and Mitigation as the council's vice chair. The project's nine (9) components namely: Hydrometric Sensor Development, Disaster Risk Exposure Assessment for Mitigation-Light Detection and Ranging (DREAM-LIDAR) 3D mapping; Enhancing Geohazards Mapping through LIDAR; Flood Information Network (FloodNET) Project; Disaster Management Using WebGIS; Doppler System Development; Landslide Sensors Development Project; Storm Surge inundation Mapping, and Weather Information Integration for System fast track the implementation of the said project. Aided by rain controlled airplanes, weather air balloons and others has made such technological leap attained to the demand of the time.

In continuously supporting the Licheon Strategy, particularly No. 5 "Expand Early Intervention and Education of Children with Disabilities" through S&T Promotion/Advocacy, DOST V in coordination with DepEd shall conduct the "Forum on DRRM/CCA cum Poster Making Contest for SPED Students." This one-day activity will highlight the forum proper and contest in the morning and afternoon schedules, respectively. DOST-PAGASA and PHIVOLCS representatives and DRRM/CCA (OCD) focal persons shall serve as the forum resource speakers and contest judges.

Priority sector for DRRM/CCA include the PWDs, Senior Citizens, Women and Children. Increasing awareness through the technology developed and its application is beneficial to them. As DOST's information guide/monitoring system within reach of people especially with coming disasters and unpredictable weather changes, disaster preparedness and mitigation through advisories/warnings in real time will enable the Bicolanos we serve attain a better prepared, safer and resilient community.

**II. Participation:**

- All SPED student-contestants are required to submit the following:
  1. Duly accomplished participation/endorsement form (Form 1)
  2. Waiver signed by the parent/guardian (Form 2)
- Use of indigenous materials is preferred during the contest. All contestants must be equipped with the art/coloring materials (use of medium depends on the participant's choice). The organizers shall provide the illustration board only.
- Theme will be given before the contest proper.
- There will only be thirteen (13) contestants subject to the recommendation by DepEd/SPED center.

**III. Conduct Proper:**

- Registration of eligible contestants starts at 9:00a.m. and ends at 9:30a.m. 27 July 2016.
- This Poster Making is an on-the-spot contest. An entry will be identified by the code to be attached to it.
- The allotted time is two (2) hours for all contestants, to start and end the preparation of the artwork at the same time.
- Judging will be done immediately after the contest whose results (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes winners) will be announced on the day of the contest.
- Judging is final and unappealable.

**IV. Criteria for Judging**

Relevance to the theme	:	25%
Creativity	:	25%
Presentation (Use of materials/neatness)	:	20%
Appeal	:	30%
TOTAL	:	100%

**V. Prizes**

- All contestants and their coaches will receive Certificates of Participation.
- In recognition to the student-contestants' outstanding artwork, contest winners and their coaches will receive Certificates of Merit. They too, are entitled to receive cash awards as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Prize	P5,000
2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize	P3,000
3 <sup>rd</sup> Prize	P2,000
