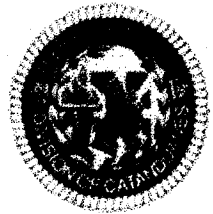

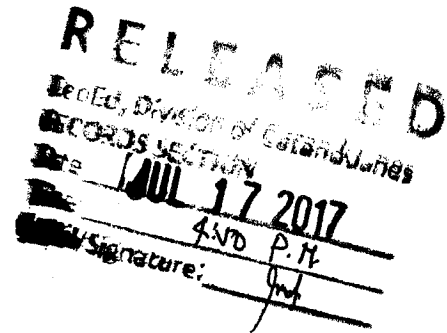


Re : STOP THE VIOLENCE (STV) TRAINING
