INTER-HIGH SCHOOL HISTORY QUIZ CONTEST November 22, 2013

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The quiz contest is open to all bonafide secondary students currently enrolled in any public, private, and technical school in Catanduanes.
- 2. Only one (1) student shall represent each school in the contest.
- 3. Any sign or form of coaching from the audience shall be ground for the nullification of the questions or the answer.
- 4. Any participant who violates the rules and regulations shall be disqualified.
- 5. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and non-contestable. Querries will not be entertained.
- 6. Registration fee of THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P 300.00) ONLY will be collected for every school to defray the cost of snacks, certificates, and prizes.

MECHANICS

- 1. The contest is divided into three levels:
 - Easy Round
 - Difficult Round
 - Clincher Round
- In the easy round, twenty (20) questions shall be given; fifteen (15) questions for the difficult round; and, ten (10) questions for the clincher round. Questions in all rounds will cover the following areas:
 - Physical, Social, and Cultural Environment of the Philippines
 - Spanish Conquest, Spanish Government, and Spanish Colonial System
 - Filipino Revolts and Nationalism
 - Propaganda Movement, Philippine Revolution, and Katipunan
 - American Regime
 - The Commonwealth of the Philippines
 - Japanese Occupation
 - Liberation
 - Third and Fourth Republic
 - Philippine Presidents (Profile and Significant Achievements)
 - Philippine Current Events
- 3 All questions will be raffled. Questions will be read only twice by the quizmaster/s.
- 4. For the type of tests: multiple choice for the easy round and identification for the difficult and clincher round.
- 5. Only ten seconds shall be allotted for answering each question unless specified by the quizmaster/s.
- Answers to the questions in all rounds shall be written in the cardboard provided. In answering the multiple choice, contestants are required to write capital (bold) letters.
- 7. Answer spelled incorrectly shall not be considered. If the question ask for a name, complete name should be written.
- 8. Only the assigned proctor for each contestant shall collect and raise the cardboard.
- 9. Only the quizmaster/s will announce the correct answer and correct spelling. The proctor shall raise the yellow flaglet for a correct answer.
- 10. Substitution shall not be allowed.
- 11. In case of tie (all contestants will proceed to the clincher round, no elimination), additional question shall be given until the tie is broken.
- 12. There will be only one winner for the first second, and third prizes, respectively.
- 13. The three contestants garnering the highest scores shall be declared the first second, and third prizes winner of the contest.
- 14. Winners will received cash prizes, medals, and trophy.
- 15. Certificates and token of participation shall be given to all participants and coaches.
