DIVISION ORIENTATION ON THE CONDUCT OF READING ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES I, II AND III

To: OIC –Chiefs of CID and SGOD Education Program Supervisors Division Coordinators Public Schools District Supervisors Heads of Elementary Schools

- 1. In line with the objectives of the Every Child A Reader Program (ECARP), a Reading Assessment for all Grades I, II and III learners shall be conducted in March 2015 in all elementary schools in this Division.
- 2. This assessment has for its objectives to:
 - a. assess the reading competence of all learners in Grades I, II and III along word recognition and reading comprehension based on reading standards:
 - b. identify the level of reading competence and learning outcomes along reading instruction;
 - c. **utilize** reports as an important input in conceptualizing effective reading interventions in schools; and
 - d. **utilize data for educational research.**
- 3. In this connection, a Division Orientation for the Conduct of the Reading Assessment for Grades I. II and III will be held on February 9, 10 and 11, 2015 for Grades I, II and III respectively at the Division Office Conference Hall C.
- 4. Participants to this orientation are ten (10) key teachers from each Grade Level per district who possess the necessary competence and facilitating skills to orient the teachers who will be involved in the administration of the reading test in their respective districts. All PSDS and Coordinating Principals are likewise required to attend the division orientation.
- 5. A registration of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 250.00) to cover 2 snacks and 1 lunch shall be deducted from the respective school MOOE of the participants subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Actual travel expense shall likewise be charged against local/school funds.
- 6. For information, wide dissemination and compliance.
