2015 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC)

To: Public Schools District Supervisors Secondary/Elementary School Heads (Public and Private Schools)

- 1. In line with the thrust to promote responsible and free journalism pursuant to the provisions of Sections 2 and 8 of Republic Act No. 7079, this division through the Division Association of Secondary School Paper Advisers (DASSPA) and the Division Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (DAESPA) is conducting the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) on November 5-7, 2015 at Catanduanes National High School Auditorium for the opening and awarding ceremonies and contest venues at Virac Pilot Elementary School.
- 2. The implementing guidelines for the individual and Group Contests stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 9 s. 2014 (Enclosure Nos. 3 to 7) shall be strictly adhered to.
- 3. The conference theme this year is " The Role of $21^{\rm st}$ Century Journalists in Upholding Good Governance, Leadership and Transparency". Said activity aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches.
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness.
 - provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career.
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media, and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 4. The Conference activities shall include the following:
 - a. Individual Contests (English and Filipino)
 - Editorial Writing
 - News Writing
 - Feature Writing
 - Sports Writing
 - Editorial Cartooning
 - Photo Journalism
 - Copy reading and Headline Writing
 - Science and Health Writing
 - b. Group Contests (English and Filipino)
 - Scriptwriting and Broadcasting
 - Collaborative Publishing
 - School Paper
 - c. Search for outstanding school paper advisers and campus journalists

- 5. Participants to this conference must come from a school with a school paper. Each participant shall pay a registration fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) which shall cover the cost of meals and snacks and honorarium of speakers and guests, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses. All expenses relative to the participation in this conference shall be charged to the school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE)/local funds/campus journalism funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. Participants from private schools shall make their own arrangements to source out funds relative to their participation for the activity.
- 6. Five winners in the individual events, radio broadcasting and collaborative publishing in both English and Filipino categories shall be declared, but only the TOP THREE (Individual events) and the best team for radio broadcasting and collaborative publishing shall represent the Division in the upcoming Regional Schools Press Conference at Sorsogon National High School, Sorsogon City Division on January 13-16, 2016.
- 7. Likewise, the top five winners in the Search for Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists will be declared, together with the top ten winners in the school paper contest by section (News Section/Pahinang Balita, Editorial Section/Pahinang Editoryal, Feature Section/Pahinang Lathalain, Sports Section/Pahinang Pampalakasan, Science and Technology Section/Pahinang Agham at Teknolohiya and Layout and Page Design Category/Kategoryang Pag-aanyo at Disenyo ng Pahina).
- 8. Schools that will join in the school paper contest either in hard or e-document(pdf) format should submit the draft of their school paper entry in printed form (18" x 12"-elementary, 18" x 24- secondary, 3 copies) and pertinent documents for the Search for Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalist must be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), attn.: Dr. Gina B. Pantino, Education Program Supervisor) on or before OCTOBER 30, 2015.
- 9. Results of the school paper contest and Search for the Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist shall be announced during the Division Schools Press Conference.
- 10. Participating schools shall strictly follow the "No School Paper, No Student Contestant" policy.
- 11. A parade of delegates with their banners on Day 1 at the Schools Division Office will mark the start of the Conference, thus their uniform shirt colors viz:

Zone 1 - Red

Zone 2 - White

Zone 3 - Mint Green

Zone 4 - Royal Blue

12. In order to facilitate accommodation of delegates, a PRE- REGISTRATION of all schools in the elementary and secondary levels is required through the school paper advisers and be remitted to the association's treasurer (elementary and secondary) on OCTOBER 23, 2015 at the Curriculum Implementation Division Office. Payment of registration fees shall no longer be done during the actual conduct of the DSPC.
