Search for Outstanding Lead Program Implementer (Funded and Unfunded)

Guidelines:

The search is open to all Functional Divisions (FD) and all program implementers of the three FDs at the SDO Proper. The heads of the FD shall nominate all their program implementers be it funded and non-funded.

The nominator shall accomplish the nomination prescribed form attached to the Unnumbered Memorandum dated November 6, 2023, "Addendum to DM No. 449 s. 2023 re: ONDRA CATANDUNGAN AWARDS 2023".

The Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) shall be strictly adhered to in all the screening processes from nomination to awarding ceremonies.

All documents to be presented should be authentic. No evidence or lack of evidence presented for each of the criteria shall mean zero (0) points.

Only candidates who obtained sixty (60) points shall proceed to the validation and interview stages.

Candidates who are aggrieved may file a protest addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent before the ONDRA awarding ceremony. The SDS shall have the final and irrevocable decision on complaints filed by the candidates.

Winners will be declared during the SDO Year-End Coordination Meeting and Christmas Party.
