

CALL FOR KABRIGADA PAGBASA 2021 VOLUNTEERS

- 1. The DepEd ROV - Education Support Services Division (ESSD) in partnership with World Vision Philippines, Smart Foundation, and this Office, will be spearheading the KABRIGADA PAGBASA 2021, a call for Brigada Pagbasa volunteers for improving the literacy of the learners ready for the opening of classes for SY 2021-2022.
- BRIGADA PAGBASA, as a form of Brigada Eskwela initiative, an after-school reading program that envisions to bring together DepEd partners, experts, change-makers, policy-makers, and other stakeholders across all sectors from international and local agencies and organizations in the public and private sectors to form collaborations to help all learners read and become functionally literate.
- 3. KaBrigada Pagbasa Volunteers have the following options:
 - a. Volunteer Reader He/she may read a book to his/her recipient child/children within the community)
 - b. Volunteer Tutor KaBrigada may become a volunteer tutor by selecting child/children within their community by devoting 1 hour everyday on teaching them how to read
 - c. Volunteer Book Donors they are organizations, private individuals and other partners who may not have time to read a book or tutor, but willing to share by donating reading materials and resources to the school to be used during Brigada Pagbasa.
 - d. Volunteer Support they are organizations, private individuals and other partners who are willing to support a volunteer tutor and their tutee by providing snacks, school supplies and other resources during the conduct of Brigada Pagbasa.
- KaBrigada Volunteer Readers and Tutors must be a resident of the community wherein their recipient learners and tutees reside. This is to avoid the possibility of sharing Covid-19 virus.
- KaBrigada Volunteer Book Donor and Support may come from the National Government Agencies (NGA's), Local Government Units, private companies, and other interested individuals. Their donations/resources shall be distributed to their selected school/s.
