

ADJUSTMENT OF LEARNING DELIVERY DUE TO SUSPENSION OF CLASSES

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Secondary and Elementary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 22 s. 2024, in case of suspension of face to face classes due to calamities and emergencies, and in areas where circumstances and resources permits, school heads have the discretion to choose any of the Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs) to support continued learning such as modular distance learning, online distance learning or blended learning, where feasible.
2. School Heads must inform the OIC- Schools Division Superintendent through their respective Public Schools District Supervisors if they decide to implement ADMs.
3. Learners who missed their learning activities due to class suspensions caused by disruptions such as disasters, or emergencies resulting from natural or human induced hazards, shall be given due considerations regarding their attendance and the completion of their learning tasks.
4. The conduct of make -up classes shall be done when online or modular learning is not feasible. School heads, in consultation with teachers and parents/guardians on schedule for all levels except Kindergarten to address missed competencies. Classes can be held during extended hours or on Saturdays to maximize learning recovery
5. Schools must, on quarterly basis, report the types of class suspensions, the circumstances therein, and ADMs utilized during class suspensions. For schools wherein teachers were not required to report to schools during suspensions, teachers shall report the type of ADM implemented as part of the quarterly reporting of the schools using attached templates to be submitted through their respective PSDSs. A District Summary Report shall be forwarded to the Schools Division Office through the ADM Focal Person.
6. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
