

Aligned with the aim of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to highlight the benefits of Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) to young people, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct an Orientation and Infomercial Contest on CSE. This is a regional advocacy for quality CSE that will empower students to lead a healthy, safe and productive lives.

An online orientation on Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) and discussion on the development of an infomercial will be on January 21, 2023, at 8:00 am to 12:00 nn, via Zoom platform. The activity shall involve selected students from Junior High School or Senior High School, preferably representing an active organization and their teacher-advisers. It is highly encouraged that the division CSE coordinators shall join the online CSE orientation. The slot per division indicated below shall be observed.

As an offshoot of the student's participation in the CSE orientation, each division shall choose representatives to compete in the CSE Infomercial contest. The official contestants by division shall submit the scanned image of the accomplished entry forms (found in the enclosure), certified by the school principals on or before January 27, 2023, at email address: ma.lorico@deped.gov.ph. All entries should be endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendents/Assistant Schools Division Superintendents.

The development of the infomercial and other preparations shall be done after class hours and during weekend. The deadline on the submission of entries will be on February 3, 2023. The participating divisions shall create a google drive link labeled, CSE_Infomercial _SDO___. This should be shared to the regional AP supervisor, Ma. Leilani R. Lorico in her email address.

All student and teacher participants shall receive certificates of participation. The top three student-winners shall receive certificates of recognition and cash prizes while their coaches shall be awarded with certificates of merit. All non-winners shall receive consolation prizes. The results shall be announced in a virtual activity to be communicated in a separate Regional Advisory.

REGIONAL INFOMERCIAL CONTEST ON COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALITY EDUCATION (CSE) GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

 Participants must be a pair of students who are enrolled this S.Y. 2022-2023. They should be in Junior High School or Senior High School. The coach can choose from the following options:

a. both male

d. both JHS

b. both female

e. both SHS

c. female and male

f. combination of JHS and SHS

2. There shall be one (1) teacher-coach per division entry.

- 3. The contestants should have participated in the regional CSE orientation on January 21, 2022.
- 4. It is preferred that contestants are active members of a school/division organization.
- 5. The campaign tagline of the contest is "With CSE, I can do and achieve more!" It should revolve on the core message: CSE gives confidence, a sense of self-worth and life skills needed in life.
- 6. The contestants shall give a title to their entries anchored on the CSE campaign tag line and core message. They can be creative by involving characters in the infomercial.
- 7. The infomercial must be produced in HD File, MP4 format. The clarity and quality of the video should not be sacrificed.
- 8. It should run not more than three (3) minutes including the title screen and credit titles. Language preferred is English or Filipino.
- 9. The infomercial must be original and should have not been presented/submitted in other contest.
- 10.It must contain photos and footages that are original. Copyrighted music material may be used but it should come from available resources in public domain. Its sources must be duly cited.
- 11. The entries should not contain any vulgar and sexually explicit materials.
- 12. The informercials must be uploaded in a Google Drive labeled, CSE_Infomercial _SDO___. This should be shared to the regional AP supervisor, Ma. Leilani R. Lorico at email address: ma. lorico@deped.gov.ph not later than February 3, 2023.
- 13. The criteria for judging are:
 - Relevance to the Theme (40%). The content of the infomercial must be related to the CSE core message.
 - Creativity and Originality (20%). The ideas and core message must be conveyed in artistic manner. It should be unique from any other published works.
 - Production Quality (20%). The quality of the video should include smooth transitions, sharp focus, proper lighting, dynamically balanced audio and sounds, and engaging music.
 - Viewers Impact (20%). The video must catch the attention of the viewers and must engage them from the onset to the end.
- 14. All submitted entries will be the property of DepEd Region V and will be utilized for CSE advocacy campaigns.
- 15. The decision of the Board of Judges is final, non-appealable, and irrevocable.
