No. 037, s. 2026**SUBMISSION OF QUARTERLY LEARNING ASSESSMENT RESULTS (QLAR) AND ANALYSES**

1. Anchored on DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016, entitled *Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program*, and Division Memorandum No. 50, s. 2025, titled *Automated Quarterly Assessment Data Collection System*, all public elementary and secondary schools are hereby tasked to submit their Quarterly Learning Assessment Results (QLAR) covering the 3rd and 4th Quarters of School Year 2024–2025 and the 1st and 2nd Quarters of School Year 2025–2026, together with an interpretation of assessment results, for purposes of consolidation, validation, compliance reporting, and analysis.
2. The elementary-level QLAR shall be consolidated and uploaded by trained District ICT Coordinators, while secondary schools shall directly upload their reports through the designated link below on or before **January 14, 2025**.

3. For the elementary level, schools shall **submit their QLAR with a school-level analysis to the District ICT Coordinator**, under the guidance of the Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS). The trained District ICT Coordinators shall consolidate and upload the QLAR, while district-level interpretation and analysis shall be prepared to identify trends, learning gaps, and priority intervention areas.
4. For the secondary level, schools shall **directly upload** their QLAR together with a school-level analysis through the designated submission link. The submitted data and analyses shall serve as basis for school-based instructional planning and division-level monitoring and reporting.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this memorandum is desired.
