RESUMPTION OF CLASSES AND CONDUCT OF MID-YEAR INSET

TO

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

Chiefs, CID and SGOD

All Others Concerned

- This office announces the resumption of distance learning classes starting February 2, 2022.
- As such, teachers shall resume the usual teaching and learning activities under the distance learning modality. It is reminded that under Alert Level 3, only 60% of the employees should report onsite while 40% shall be on an alternative work arrangement. This should be discussed and agreed on by the school head, teaching and non-teaching personnel.
- It is emphasized the face-to-face or in-person classes are not yet allowed. 3.
- To complete the second quarter of the school year uninterrupted, the conduct of the mid-year In-Service Training (INSET) shall be on February 23-27, 2022. The INSET should allow the teachers to discuss the results of the 2nd quarter performance of the students and have an informed decision on the needed intervention for the students, especially those who are lagging in grades, at-risk of dropping out, and their mental wellness.
- 5. It is reiterated that the following provisions of DepEd Order No. 29, s, 2021 shall apply:
 - 2.2 The first two days of the five-day mid-year break may be spent to evaluate the school's progress attained in the implementation of the educational programs, projects, and activities (PPAs), as well as to review the performance of the teachers and the school staff in order to address concerns through collaborative effort. The last three days may be devoted

for the conduct of the school-based In-Service Training (INSET) activities for the teachers' continued professional development and the preparation for their Instructional Materials (IMs).

The schools may opt to resort to virtual conduct of INSET considering the covid situations in their area.
