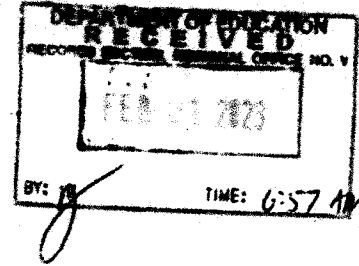

Greetings from DSWD Field Office VI!

The Department through the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program is set to facilitate the registration of Set 12 household program beneficiaries starting this January onward

The registration is to sustain the program's relevance in the coming years as an institutionalized protection measure by continuing to reach more poor households to the extent its annual budget allows. For this year, Bicol region has a target of one hundred five thousand, seven hundred twenty-seven (105, 727) potential households for registration to replace the households that voluntarily waived/graduated/exited from the program.

As additional procedure on validation and registration of the households, the City/Municipal Operations Offices are encouraged to put up one-stop-shop services to address concerns that may arise during the registration such as but not limited to birth certificate and not updated school record.

With this, may we respectfully request for your support through information dissemination to Principals and School Heads in the elementary and secondary schools regarding this matter. There will be Pantawid staff who will also coordinate with them for the schedule and venue of the registration.
