- 1. To ensure the school preparedness and safety of all learners, school personnel and properties, this Office reiterates the observance of DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2011 re: Disaster Preparedness Measures for Schools and DepEd Memorandum No. 108, s. 2016 re: Preparedness Measures for the Rainy Season.
- 2. School Heads and SDRRM Coordinators are requested to prepare and take precautionary measures for the safety of school offices, facilities, equipment, pertinent school documents, and textbooks and transfer them in the elevated room of the building. For other preparedness measures, you may refer to the attached DepEd issuances).
- 3. Schools that may be affected by severe flooding shall be immediately reported via Rapid Assessment and Damages Report (RADaR) direct to DepEd DRRMS by sending a text message to the following feedback numbers: 09288718053 (smart), 09152053244 (globe) and to the Division Office at 09958438071 using RADaR 1 & @ format (please see attached) as per directed by DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2015 entitled Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordination Protocol.



Kindly check the following before sending: [1] Only the answers are typed, no need to input questions, (2) No spaces between commas, and, (3) RADAR1 and SCHOOL ID is indicated. By sending this form via SMS. please note that the sender is certifying that the information sent is true and accurate. Any inaccorate and incorrect information shall be the responsibility of the sender.

Instructions to Divisions:

[15] Designation of sender

A link to the consolidated RADaR shall be given to divisions so that they can check the RADaR1 data sent by school heads. Divisions are in-charge of ensuring all affected schools send RADaRs via SMS and shall be responsible for schools without reports. Only divisions with DepEd e-mail accounts can access and check the RADaR submissions of schools. For divisions without DepEd e-mail accounts, kindly inquire with your ICT Coordinators on how to register for a DepEd e-mail account.
