# CHANGE IN AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 141, S. 2017

(World Teachers' Month 2017 Sports Olympics)

1. The **World Teacher's Month 2017 Sports Olympics** was announced through Division Memorandum No. 141, s. 2017. However, paragraph 6 is changed as follows:

Transportation and other incidental expenses of participants maybe be charged against respective school MOOE/ local funds and/or other fund subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 2. Since the activities fall on Saturdays, this office authorizes the granting of service credits for participating teachers in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for participating non-teaching staff pursuant to paragraph 5.3, letter K of the Joint Circular No. 2 of the CSC and DBM dated October 4, 2004.
- 3. Enclosed are the **changes** in the number of competing zones, shirt color and number of players and **additional information** on the venue, tournament and event guidelines, point system, and equipment.
- 4. All other provisions in the memorandum still remain.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

5. 1 player: 1 event rule will be followed.

- 6. The deadline of submission of the list of players/ officiating officials: Sept. 4, 2017 during the CID meeting.
- 7. Food and beverages are to be provided by respective zones (KKB).
- 8. Drawing of lots will be done by event.

#### **Event Guidelines/ Rules/ Mechanics** B.

- 1. Basketball
  - a. FIBA rules will be followed
  - b. 15 players to play (all males)
  - e. 8 minutes per period (1st to 3rd); 10 mins for the 4th period
  - d. Passerelle rule will be followed
  - e. Single Round Robin scheme (20 games)
  - f. Schedule: Four Saturdays
- 2. Volleyball
  - a. FIVA rules will be followed
  - b. 10 players (all females)
  - c. 25 points/set; 3 sets
  - d. Single elimination scheme
  - e. Schedule: First 2 Saturdays (Sept 9 and Sept 16)
- Chess
  - a. FIDE rules will be followed.
  - b. Chess will be played as a team competition for the MALE and one team for the FEMALE. A team shall compose of two (2) players. There shall be separate championship for the MALES and FEMALES in each zone.
  - c. Single round robin scheme.
  - d. One (1) point for a win, one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) point for a draw, and zero (0) for a loss.
  - e. In case of tie, the following rules will be applied:

    - Sonnen Von Berger ii.
    - Most number of victories with the black pieces iii.
    - Toss coin iv.
  - f. Schedule: Four Saturdays
- 4. Badminton
  - a. FIBA rules will be followed
  - b. 2 males, 2 females (1 male to play in Singles Men, 1 female to play in Singles Women, the remaining 1 male and 1 female to play in the Mixed Doubles)
  - c. Events: Singles Men, Singles Women and Mixed Doubles
  - d. Players to play in Singles are not allowed to play in MD
  - e. Single/Knock-out elimination
  - f. Draw Lots shall be made on the first day of competition
  - g. Schedule: Four Saturdays
- 5. Table Tennis
  - a. ITTF rules will be followed
  - b. 2 males, 2 females (1 male to play in Singles Men, 1 female to play in Singles Women, the remaining 1 male and 1 female to play in the Mixed Doubles)
  - c. Events: Singles Men, Singles Women and Mixed Doubles
  - d. Players to play in Singles are not allowed to play in MD
  - e. Game of Succession
  - f. Knock out system
