

The administration of the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA) for Grade 3, National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6), and National Achievement Test for Grade 12 (NATG12) for school year 2023-2024 corollary to DM No. 016, s. 2024 and RM No. 292, s. 2024 are scheduled on the

following testing windows, to wit: Target Participants/Test Takers **Test Administration** Assessment Schedule/Testing Program Window Census: Public & Private schools NATG12 March 20-21, 2024 Census: Current Grade 12 learners of SY 2023-2024 Census: Public & Private Schools April 5, 2024 NATG6 Sampling: Current Grade 6 learners of SY 2023-2024 Census: Public Schools Only April 17, 2024 **ELLNA** Census: Current Grade 3 learners of SY 2023-2024

2. NATG6 and NATG12 are exit assessments which aim to determine if Grades 6 and 12 learners are meeting the learning standards in the Elementary & Senior High School Curriculum. NATG6 shall measure the 21st Century Skills specifically Problem-Solving, Information Literacy, and Critical Thinking skills using learning

areas in English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan. While, NATG12 shall focus on assessing the core SHS learning areas of Science, Philosophy, Language and Communication, Media and Information Literacy, Mathematics, Humanities, Wika at Komunikasyon, and Social Science. The test is in a multiple-choice format using English and Filipino Languages in varying levels of skills and progressive in nature.

- 3. Moreover, ELLNA aims to determine if Grade 3 pupils are meeting the learning standards in early language, literacy and numeracy which shall be administered in a multiple-choice item format in English, Filipino and Mother Tongue languages. It shall serve as a tool to identify and articulate performance indicators and outcomes for measuring performance in the formulation of plans in policies as stipulated in D.O. 29, s. 2022 titled Adoption of the Basic Monitoring and Evaluation Framework (BEMEF).
- 4. The Grade 12 learners under the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program shall **not** be required to take the NATG12 in SY 2023-2024. Further, **currently enrolled** Grade 6 learners will be sample in each public and private school to take the NATG6. The sample size per school was determined by the Bureau of Education assessment (BEA). All **currently enrolled Grade 3 learners in Public Schools** shall Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA).
- 5. In lieu of this, this division shall conduct orientations on the administration of ELLNA, NATG6 and NATG12 on March 16, 2024 (Saturday) & March 26, 2024 via MS Teams, with the specified schedule below.

The conduct of the tests is pursuant to DO 022, s. 2023 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024 and DO 003, s. 2024 titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024).
- 3. In accordance with DO 027, s. 2022, titled Conduct of Rapid Assessment in School Year 2021-2022 for Learning Recovery as well as in Preparation for the



- 2024 Baseline System Assessment, the current Grades 3, 6, and 12 learners of the present SY will be taking the assessments.
- 4. The **ELLNA** will be administered to all currently enrolled Grade 3 learners in public schools, while the **NATG6** will be administered to all public and private schools, and learners will be sampled in each school. On the other hand, the **NATG12** will be administered to all currently enrolled Grade 12 learners in public and private schools.
- 5. The three assessment programs will be administered on a paper-based modality to all regional offices (ROs), schools division offices (SDOs), and schools.
- 6. In reference to DO 29, s. 2022 titled **Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework**, DepEd has to identify and articulate performance indicators and outcomes for measuring performance in the development of plans and policies. These indicators and outcomes will be used for the assessment of the effectiveness and efficiency of the delivery of education services. The results of system assessments will serve as evidence for the improvement of the curriculum implementation.
- 7. The **ELLNA** is to be administered at the end of Grade 3 as a key stage assessment to determine if students are meeting the learning standards in early language, literacy, and numeracy. The test is in a multiple-choice item format. Moreover, English, Filipino, and Mother Tongue shall be the languages for this assessment.
- 8. The NATG6 and NATG12 are exit assessments under the national assessment framework of the K to 12 Basic Education Program. These tests are designed to determine if Grade 6 and Grade 12 learners are meeting the learning standards in the Elementary and Senior High School (SHS) curriculum. The exit assessments shall cover 21st Century Skills (Problem-Solving, Information Literacy, and Critical Thinking) using learning areas in English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan as content in NATG6, and the core SHS learning areas of Science, Philosophy, Language and Communication, Media and Information Literacy, Mathematics, Humanities, Wika at Komunikasyon, and Social Science in NATG12. The test design is progressive in nature wherein test items measure varying levels of skills in a multiple-choice format using English and Filipino languages.
- 9. BEA will manage the national implementation of the ELLNA, NATG6, and NATG12 with the assistance of the ROs and SDOs. BEA will conduct a virtual orientation for Regional Testing Coordinators, Division Testing Coordinators, and SDO Private School Supervisors on the administration of the tests. 

Additional Guidelines on the Administration of the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 (NATG12), National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6), and Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA) for SY 2023-2024

In line with the DepEd Memorandum No. 016, s. 2024 titled Administration of the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment, National Achievement Test for Grade 6, and National Achievement Test for Grade 12 for School Year 2023-2024, here are the additional guidelines for the conduct of the tests:

Participating Learners

- All currently enrolled Grade 12 learners in the formal school system in public and private schools shall take the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 (NATG12). The Grade 12 learners under the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program shall not be required to take the NATG12 in SY 2023-2024.
- Currently enrolled Grade 6 learners will be sampled in each public and private school to take the National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6). The sample size per school was determined by the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA).
- 3. All currently enrolled Grade 3 learners in public schools shall take the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA).

Participating Schools

- Only private schools operating with a government permit for SY 2023-2024 shall be included in the NATG6 and NATG12.
- 2. Newly established schools for Grades 3, 6, and 12 in SY 2023-2024 shall participate in the national tests if the test materials will suffice.
- 3. Schools that are not included in the test materials allocation list may opt to utilize the test materials of private schools within the Schools Division Office (SDO) that have ceased operation in SY 2023-2024.

Testing Centers

Participating schools shall serve as testing centers.

Test Booklets (TBs)

- 1. The TBs are **reusable** and may be reallocated within the SDO should there be any insufficiency. This means that a school may borrow TBs from another school **within the SDO**. After the test, the borrowed TBs must be returned to the original school.
- Photocopying of the TBs is strictly NOT allowed.
- Maintain the integrity of the test before, during, and after the test administration.

Answer Sheets (ASs)

If ASs are insufficient, the following strategies may be applied within the Region:

- 1. **Pool** the ASs from schools with decreased enrollment from SY 2022-2023 to SY 2023-2024 and **distribute** these to schools with increased enrollment.
- Use the ASs from schools that are temporarily/permanently closed.
- Photocopying of ASs is NOT encouraged because it is not guaranteed that
 these will be processed and released in time. The ASs are scanned by
 scanning machines or optical mark readers. Photocopied ASs cannot be read
 by scanning machines.
- 4. Grade 12 learners who will <u>not</u> be able to take the test because of the unavailability of ASs shall <u>not</u> be sanctioned for <u>not</u> taking the test.

Schedule of Tests

- 1. The SDOs, in agreement with Regional Offices (ROs), have the prerogative to schedule the test administration within the allotted testing windows as indicated in DepEd Memorandum No. 016, s. 2024.
- 2. The NATG12 shall be administered in two (2) consecutive school days.

- 2. For the NATG12, each examinee shall use one (1) TB per day. The swapping scheme of TBs in the testing room shall be implemented.
 - For Day 1, the first 15 examinees shall use TB1, while the remaining 15 examinees shall use TB2.
 - For Day 2, the Room Examiner (RE) shall swap the TBs. The first 15 examinees who use the TB1 on the 1st day shall use TB2, while TB1 shall be used by the remaining 15 examinees.
- 3. For the NATG6, each examinee shall use one (1) TB since the test proper is 2 hours and 40 minutes only, two testing sessions can be scheduled in one day to cover the required sample size of examinees. For the AM session, half of the target number of examinees shall use the allocated TBs, while the remaining half shall use the same TBs for the PM session.
