

1. EDUCO Philippines, in partnership with UNICEF and in coordination with this Office, will conduct a **Community-Based Psychological First Aid (PFA) Rollout** on **February 7 and 8, 2026**. This initiative is specifically designed for selected learners within the municipalities of Bagamanoc, Panganiban, Viga, and Caramoran who were affected by Super Typhoon (STY) Uwan.
2. This activity aims to provide essential psychological support to children affected by Super Typhoon Uwan.
3. While this is a community-based initiative, school multipurpose halls may be utilized as venues for the sessions to ensure a safe and conducive environment for the participants.
4. To ensure proper implementation, the activity will be monitored by SDO Personnel previously trained by EDUCO Philippines and the Provincial Health Office (PHO).
5. Since this activity is scheduled over a weekend, all participating personnel shall be granted two (2) days of service credits or compensatory time-off. This is in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers) and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 regarding compensatory overtime credits.
