- 1. A. Design

- Covers 21st Century Skills: Problem solving, Critical Thinking and Information Literacy
- 2. Progressive in nature
- Multiple-choice format
- 4. In English and Filipino language
- Covers Core SHS Learning Areas: Humanities, Language and Communication, Mathematics, Media and Information Literacy, Philosophy, Science and Social Science
- 6. Levels of Proficiency:

Level	MPS	Description				
Highly Proficient	90-100	At this level, the students are highly capable of solving problems, managing and communicating accurate information, and analysing and evaluating data to create/ formulate ideas.				
Profici e nt	75-89	At this level, the students are skilled in solving problems, managing and communicating accurate information, and analysing and evaluating data to create/ formulate ideas.				
Nearly Proficient	50-74	At this level, the students met the minimum level of skills of solving problems, managing and communicating accurate information, and analysing and evaluating data to create/formulate ideas.

INSTRUCTIONS ON THE SUBMISSION OF THE NAMES OF ROOM EXAMINERS NAT G12, January 30-31, 2023

- 1. Schools heads are to submit the list of teachers who will be assigned as room examiners to other schools following these criteria:
 - a. High school teacher (JHS or SHS)
 - b. Experienced in administering national/international tests
 - c. Credible and trustworthy as this assessment requires utmost confidentiality
- 2. The following format shall be followed: Name of Teacher and Position
- 3. The number of teachers to be submitted will be based on the following computation:

No. of current enrolment / 30 = No. of Teacher-examinees

Example: for a school with 255 G12 enrolees

255/30 = 8.5, thus, the school will send 9 teachers

4. Prior to the submission of hard copy, this report could be submitted online to facilitate transaction through messenger account *Frank Turalde* or the Group Chat *EsP SSH*. The deadline of submission of names is January 17, 2023.
