

All Division Supervisors are requested to pre-screen researches and ensure that the researches passed by the school Institutional Review Board and Division Scientific Review Committee before submitting for the Regional Scientific Review Committee Paper Screening. COLOR CODING of folders should be STRICTLY followed to wit:

Life Science Team Life Science Individual Yellavr Applied/Physical Indv - Red Applied/Physical Individual-Blue Robotics Team - Orange White Robotics Individual Violet Innovation Expo.

Entries should be submitted to the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) Office of DepEd Region V not later than October 16, 2018. Likewise, soft copy of official endorsements (from school to division, division to region) should be in EXCEL FORMAT following the template under Enclosure 3. This should be emailed to depedsciencerov@gmail.com on or before October 22, 2018.





5. No Registration Fee will be collected to the Science Olympics participants while researchers and coaches in the Science Fair and Innovation Expo shall pay a Registration Fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) to supplement costs for cash prizes, materials, medals, plaques, certificates and other operational expenses EXCEPT food and lodging of participants. Likewise, other expenses including the honoraria of the Scientific Review Committee and Judges shall be taken from the Regional Funds. Registration Fee and all other expenses of participants relative to the conduct of this activity is chargeable against school MOOE/Local Funds and/or other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
