

2021 National Disaster Resilience Month Simultaneous Tree Planting Activity

- 1. Under Executive Order No. 29 declaring the month of July as the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) enjoining all Filipinos to observe the celebration through the conduct of activities relative to building disaster resilience, covering the four thematic areas: Prevention and Mitigation, Preparedness, Response and Rehabilitation, and Recovery.
- 2. In observance of the celebration, the **Department of Education Region V** will be conducting a **Tree Planting Activity on July 1, 2021**, dubbed as "**One Employee, One Tree/Bawat Guro, Isang Puno**" as part of the opening ceremony of the NDRM which will be spearheaded by the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (RDRRMC).
- 3. In line with these, The Schools Division Office will be joining in this activity by conducting simultaneous tree planting activity on the said date at **exactly 8:00 a.m**. All schools are enjoined to conduct the same activity and follow these guidelines:
 - Teachers that are on-site during the schedule are advised to join in the simultaneous tree planting to be conducted within the school premises.
 - Teachers that are in a work from home status are advised to do the same activity within their residence or any identified planting area in their community.
 - You may connect with your local DENR Office counterparts for seedlings or you may plant fruitbearing trees available in your areas.
 - During the conduct of the activity, all are advised to observe the strict implementation of minimum health protocols.
 - Accomplishment report with photo documentation must be submitted online through this link https://bit.ly/NDRM-TreePlanting-SDOCAT on July 2, 2021.
- 4. Further, all are reminded to observe strict compliance to minimum health protocol during the conduct of the activity.
