DIVISION ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR THE INCOMING GRADE 7 AND GRADE 4 STUDENTS FOR THE SPECIAL PROGRAM IN JOURNALISM (SPJ) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2021- 2022

1. In preparation for the Opening of Classes for school year 2021-2022 for the Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) at the Catanduanes National High School for the incoming grade 7 students and the Virac Pilot Elementary School for the incoming grade 4 pupils, please be reminded of the following requirements and screening viz:

- A recommendation letter from the school paper adviser or language teacher of the last school attended.
- 5. Certification of Grades (Note: The applicant should have a minimum rating of 85% in English and Filipino, and a general weighted average of 85% or above in grade 6)

SELECTION PROCESS:

PHASE 1: Document Evaluation

Selection Committee will evaluate the submitted requirements. They will select the top 40 pupils among the interested applicants.

PHASE 2: Assessment (60%) and Interview (40%)

Top 40 qualifiers shall proceed to an online assessment and interview through Google Meet, Facebook Messenger or Zoom to assess the language skills of the applicants. This consists of three (3) items in Filipino and three (3) items in English, a total of six (6) items multiple choice type assessment, and an interview.

Top 30 pupils after the interview will be selected as official enrollees.

The school principal/department head shall take lead in the screening, examination and interview (online) with the identified working committee under the supervision of the Education Program Supervisor in English.
