

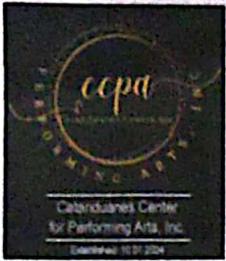

- May 6–10, 2025 – Theatre Arts – Basic Acting Workshop

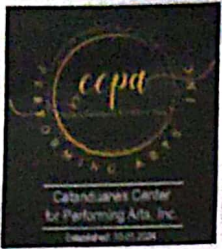

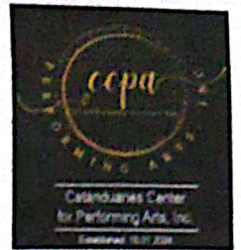
