OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

I. BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular (CSC MC) No. 3, s. 2012 entitled Program to Institutionalize Meritocracy and Excellence in Human Resource Management (PRIME-HRM), CSC Memorandum Circular No. 01, s. 2001 entitled Program on Award and Incentives for Service Excellence (PRAISE), strengthened by the implementation of DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2002 on Establishing the Programs and Awards for Service Excellence (PRAISE) in the Department of Education and in celebration of the World Teacher's Day, SDO Catanduanes holds the Search for Most Innovative Teacher in the Time of Pandemic.

As part of this activity and along encouraging, recognizing and rewarding teachers for their invaluable dedication in educating school children and immeasurable contribution towards community progress and nation-building, this division is holding the 2021 'Onra Catandungan Teacher Songwriting Contest.

II. OBJECTIVES

This contest aims to:

- a) recognize, encourage and reward teachers for their invaluable contribution to the delivery of educational services through music; and
- showcase the talents of teachers and non-teaching personnel who are musicallyinclined.

III. CONTEST GUIDELINES

A. ELIGIBILITY OF CONTESTANT

This search is open to all public elementary and secondary teaching and non-teaching personnel with regular permanent status as of August 31, 2021. There could be 1 lyricist and 1 musical arranger for an entry or the lyricist and the arranger could be the same person.

B. CONTEST PIECE

 The song composition must be the original composition of the participants (lyrics/message, musical arrangement), but appropriate genre should be used such as but not limited to Pop, Jazz, Ballad, Classical, Soul, Blues, R&B, Gospel, March, Waltz. Metallic, Hard Rock, and Hip Hop are not allowed. Choice of instrumental background is up to the writer/s.

- 2. Theme song must revolve on the theme: "Honoring the Teacher's Commitment, Resiliency and Innovativeness Amid Pandemic."
- 3. Lyrics could be written in either English or Filipino languages.
- 4. Song entries must not exceed five (5) minutes, including intro and extro. Entries must be submitted in full accompaniment version and in minus-one.
- The song must not have been used in any previous competitions or commercially released (i.e. recorded and commercially distributed, sold to the public or uploaded in any online/ social media platforms.
- Words with registered trademarks/brand names, explicit and offensive lyrics are strictly prohibited.
- All song entries (musical composition/arrangement) shall be considered FINAL once submitted, and cannot be modified or altered prior to the selection and announcement of winners.

C. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

 The lyrics evoke an emotional response from the listener 	
The lyrics are singable and memorable	
 The lyrics have an identifiable rhyme scheme or pattern 	
The lyrics are free from errors	
Song Structure and Composition	25 %
 The song has a clear theme or cohesive idea. 	
 The song has clearly identifiable sections, verse, chorus, etc. 	
The song is between 2 to 5 minutes	
Music and Melody	25 %
 The music and melody adds emotional impact of the song 	
 The music keeps the listener interested and engaged 	
 The music and lyrics fit together in a cohesive way 	
Originality	25 %
The song expresses the theme in a new or fresh way	
 The song has its unique way of engaging the listener 	
 The song has appealing characteristics to the listeners 	
TOTAL	100 %

D. EXPLANATION OF RIGHTS

The writer (s) retain/s all rights of the submitted songs. However, the SDO has the right to use the song for promotion and advocacy purposes.

IV. CONTEST MECHANICS

A. SUBMISSION OF ENTRY

- 1. Any song entry must be recorded on a flash drive or compact disc, in a clear and audible rendition, copied/saved in mp3 format, which will be submitted in two tracks: (1) with vocals in full accompaniment version and (2) minus-one version.
- Song lyrics should be printed in Microsoft Word document, sent along together with the following:
 - Name of Sender (e.g. composer(s), lyricist(s) and/or arranger(s)) and position
 - b. Contact Number
 - c. School
 - d. School Head
