- 3. School heads must see to it that the classes that will be affected by the absence of the identified school paper advisers in this memorandum are taken care of. However, if the absence of the teacher will adversely affect student learning, please notify the office of the SDS immediately so that they may be replaced.
- 4. A registration of Four Thousand and Two Hundred Pesos (Php 4,200.00) will be collected from the participants, payable to the two organizations, Bicol Campus Journalism Association, Inc. (elementary level) and Bicol Association of Campus Paper Advisers Inc. (Secondary level) upon their arrival at the venue on September 25, 2024 to defray the cost of meals, accommodation, hall rental, professional fees of resource speakers, supplies and materials as stipulated in the regional memorandum.
- 5. The participants' expenses for the registration fee, travel and miscellaneous expenses shall be charged against the division or school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE/local funds/campus journalism funds, subject to the relevant accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. All participants are expected to arrive at the venue in the afternoon of September 25, 2024 and the first dinner to be served is dinner; while the last meal to be served is afternoon snacks on September 28, 2024.
- 7. Considering that September 28, 2024 is a Saturday, all teacher-participants are entitled to a one-day vacation service credit, in congruence to the provisions set in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, re: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to teachers and its amendment in the DepEd Order.
