1. In compliance with DepEd Order No.042 s, 2024 titled *Guidelines on the Utilization of Program Support for Special Need Education (SNED)* and Memorandum DM-CT-2024-22 dated June 25, 2024, re *Recipients and Priority Expenditures of the FY 2024 Special Needs Education Program Support Fund*, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a half-day orientation on **October 18, 2024, 8:00AM to 12:00NN** at **JMAMES, Virac North District, Lanao, Virac, Catanduanes**.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. provide clear understanding of the policy guidelines governing the utilization of the SNED Support Funds for FY-2024;
 - b. discuss how the funds are allocated, including which areas or programs within special education are eligible for financial support; and
 - c. ensure that implementing schools have a comprehensive understanding on how to use the Program Support Funds (PSF) effectively to benefit learners with difficulties and disabilities.

Pursuant to the Republic Act 11650, "Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act," and DepEd Order (DO) No. 042, s. 2021, titled "Guidelines on the Utilization of Support Funds for Special Education (SPED) Program" as amended by DO 018, s. 2022, the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learning Delivery, will download the Special Needs Education Program Support Fund (SNED PSF) to DepEd offices implementing the SNED Program and schools with learners with disability (LWD) enrollment.

The provision of the Fiscal Year 2024 SNED PSF is in support of the Department's MATATAG Agenda, particularly to: **TA**ke steps to accelerate delivery of basic education facilities and services; **TA**ke good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment; and **GI**ve support to teachers to teach better.

The recipient field implementers shall be guided by the aforementioned DOs in the utilization of the fund. However, for this Fiscal Year, the following shall be prioritized:

- Recipient schools shall prioritize the formal assessment or rehabilitation of LWDs by Medical or Allied Medical specialists and the acquisition of specialized materials, devices and equipment for instructional purposes of learners with disability/difficulty.

- Recipient Regional Offices (ROs) shall prioritize the Training of Receiving Teachers on a) SNED Content and Pedagogy; b) the Use of Filipino Sign Language; c) the Development of an Individualized Education Plan; and d) the Use of Multi-Factored Assessment Tool. ROs can also use the fund for the orientation of School Heads on different SNED programs.
- Recipient Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and ROs shall prioritize using the SNED PSF for the monitoring of SNED Program Implementation and orientation of Core Trainers of SNED Programs.
- Converted Inclusive Learning Resource Centers (ILRCs) of Batches 1 and 2 shall also be provided with PSF intended to procure assistive devices, supplies, and equipment in order to make their ILRCs functional.

Annex A contains the list of DepEd Offices and Public Elementary and Secondary Schools that will be provided with SPED PSF, while Annex B is the list of ILRCs that will be provided with PSF intended to procure assistive devices, supplies, and equipment.

RO and SDO SNED Focal Persons are required to submit a report on the utilization of the SNED Fund every last week of each quarter using the template in Annex C.
