1. DepEd Order No. 42 of 2017 mandates integrating peace education into the curriculum and school activities, promoting values like peace, tolerance, and respect for diversity. This aligns with DepEd Order No. 34 of 2012, which emphasizes the role of values education in developing responsible citizens who contribute to a peaceful and just society.
2. Furthermore, DepEd Order No. 40 of 2012 mandates the integration of Gender and Development (GAD) principles into all aspects of education, promoting gender equality and respect for diversity. This further reinforces the importance of creating a learning environment that values peace, inclusivity, and respect for all.
3. Building upon these initiatives, a collaborative event titled "Peace Tayo" shall be conducted on October 24, 2024 at the Convention Center, Capitol Grounds. The initiative was jointly organized by the Schools Division Office and the Provincial Local Government Unit (PLGU) which aims to:
 1. inspire youth to champion peace education by fostering their understanding of "Diversity in Equality" and the crucial role of interfaith dialogue in creating a nonviolent society;
 2. educate participants on Gender and Cultural Norms and their impact on social order, promoting critical thinking and awareness of the need for positive change;
 3. empower youth to lead peace-promoting projects and activities by providing them with the tools and guidance to effectively collaborate, develop creative initiatives, and implement impactful solutions.



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5. **The participants of the aforementioned activity are SSLG Presidents and Advisers from the secondary schools, selected ALS teachers, Asatidz, PSDSs, and Values Restoration Officers (VROs).**
