7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

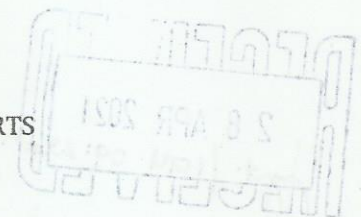
