

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4 (19)

DECLARING EVERY FRIDAY OF THE MONTH OF AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER AS THE ANTI-DENGUE DAY TO SEARCH AND DESTROY ALL MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES ANAKSYON AGAD! LABANAN ANG DENGUE! CLEAN-UP DRIVE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2019 the Department of Health (DOH) declared a national dengue epidemic that has so far claimed the lives of at least 622 people since January;

WHEREAS, today, the DOH requested the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council Chair Secretary Delfin N. Lorenzana to convene a full council meeting and declare a national dengue epidemic in the wake of the 146,062 cases recorded since January up to July 20 of this year, 98% higher than the same period in 2018;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Province of Catanduanes to adapt as it adapts the DOHSabayang 4-O'clock Habit para Deng-Get Out, focusing on the search and destroy of mosquito breeding sites, by way of one of the primary interventions to prevent and control dengue;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, SHIRLEY ARAOJO ABUNDO, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, in my capacity as the Acting Provincial Governor of Catanduanes, do herebyorder and declare the following:

- Every Friday of the month of August and September 2019 is an Aksyon Agad!
 Labanan Ang Dengue! clean up drive of the Province of Catanduanes adapting the DOH Sabayang 4-O'clock Habit para Deng-Get Out, focusing on search and destroy of mosquito breeding sites, being one of the primary interventions to prevent and control dengue in the entire province;
- In each Friday of August and September all government agencies, local government units, schools, offices, and communities shall make available their Fridays to do volunteer work within their sphere of authority to search and destroy mosquito breeding sites;
- 3. The clean-up drive shall be for a minimum of two hours to a maximum of four hours every Friday.
- 4. Everyone is urged to jointly search and destroy tuwing 4:00 o'clock para deng-get-out. Aksyon Agad! Labanan ang Dengue!

FINALLY, this Executive Order shall be given the widest possible traditional and social media coverage in order to bring the information to all Catandunganons. Everyone is encouraged to post in their social media platforms their activities on the Aksyon Agad! Labanan Ang Dengue! clean-up drive.

DONE this August 7, 2019 in Virac, Catanduanes, and is effective immediately.

Reiteration on the Secretary of Health Declaration of the National

Dengue Epidemic

In view of the increasing cases of Dengue which has exceeded by 98% compared to the same period of last year, the Secretary of Health declared the National Dengue Epidemic.

Relative to this declaration, the Department of Health-Center for Health Development Bicol order that Epidemic response be implemented simultaneously across the region, provinces, municipalities and barangays, as follows:

- Policy issuance by the Local Chief Executives in support of the 45implementation focusing on the daily Sabayang 4 o'clock Habit in all barangays.
- Reactivation of the Municipal and Barangay DRRMC members in all areas and reactivation of their Emergency Operation Centers/Incident Command System.
- Prompt and regular reporting and feed backing of dengue cases through PIDSR and FHSIS and submission to the Provincial Health Office-PESU.
- Ensure all health facilities have Oral Rehydration Salts and household chlorination corners for management of cases and practice coordinated referrals to tertiary facilities.
- All government and private hospitals to activate their Health Emergency Preparedness Response and Recovery Plan (HEPRRP) Disaster Risk Reduction Management for Health (DRRMH) Plan or safe Hospitals Plan for patient surge by setting up the Triage, Dengue fast lane, isolation areas for Dengue cases, installation of long-lasting insecticide-treated nets in their dengue wards.
- Conduct of regular weekly vector surveillance and provide report to the next higher level.
- Continue mobilization of ABKD, BHERTS and other partners for the daily implementation of Sabayang 4 o'clock habit.
- Intensify Risk Communication on Dengue prevention and control, early consultation and prompt management.
- Say yes to fogging using the right chemical, with the right preparation, at all right time using the right equipment.
