Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 7, s. 2016 re: School Year (SY) 2015-2016 End of School Year Rites, kindergarten classes in both public and private schools shall NO longer conduct the 2016 Moving Up Ceremony.

Only secondary schools with Grade 10 learners who will complete Junior High School are required to hold the Moving Up Ceremony or completion. This year's theme focuses on " Kabataang Mula sa K to 12, Tagapagdala ng Kaunlaran sa Bansang Pilipinas"

With this, all kindergarten classes in both public and private schools will join in the Recognition Ceremony.

In giving awards for the Kindergarten pupils/ pre-school children, the exceptional skills, talents and character traits of the learners must be considered. No academic awards/ with honors shall be awarded to kindergarten pupils. Since, the curriculum used by the kindergarten classess offered no specific learning areas rather than an integration of the latter.
