

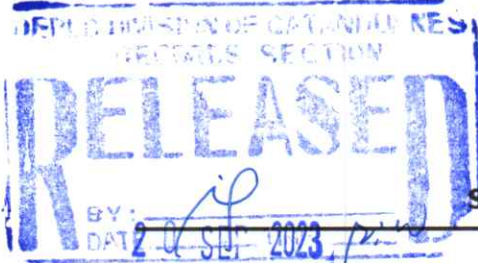

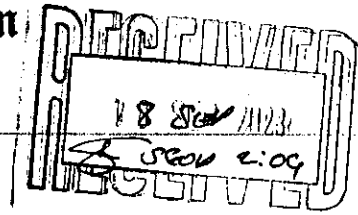

Building, UST Campus, San Pedro, Manila. Along with USTAAI members, the 2022 AAIG Summit is in partnership with the UST Graduate School Center for Continuing Professional Education and Development (CGSEAD) and its faculty members. **AAIG Nexus: New Visions, New Frontiers, New Strategies and Practices.**

The meeting was led by AAIG lead convener, Dr. Henry B. Tolentino, AAIG convener emeritus, Dr. Evelyn A. Sanico, GSCCED Director, Assoc. Prof. Jaclyn T. Aguilon, USTAAI President, Dr. Dwight M. The Summit's carefully curated line-up of speakers will focus on a state-relevant topics and covered on the following objectives:

- To leverage and advance the use of technology-driven approaches with humanistic strategies in community development; and

It is also noted by the unwavering support of UST Secretary, Rev. Fr. Richard Ang, O.F.M., the organizing committee has been ramping up its efforts since the preparations began on April 1. The registration of the participants started on July 2023.

The AAIG Caravan is aimed at cascading the teaching of AAIG Summit and is intended to stimulate the emergence of AAIG convergence community of educators and advocates in different strategic fields around the country. Last year's AAIG Caravan series was attended by more than 1,000 thousand participants.
