
- 1. Attached is the Regional Memorandum re: 2022 Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) Main Survey.

The Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) is the largest international study designed and developed by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). Its goal is to evaluate education systems worldwide by testing the skills and knowledge of 15-year students, who are approaching the end of their compulsory education. Students are tested how to apply their knowledge in real life situations and problems, rather than testing their knowledge recall. Every three years, participating countries assess their 15-year-olds in the three cognitive domains: Reading, Mathematics, and Science, and in PISA 2022, **Mathematics** is the major domain and **Creative Thinking** as an innovative domain.

As one of the participants in the 2022 PISA for international benchmarking, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Assessment Education (BEA), that serves as the National Center for the programme, spearheads the PISA administration per DepEd Order No. 295, s. 2017 re: "Policy Guidelines on System Assessment in the K to 12 Basic Education Program".

The Main Survey (MS) will be conducted from March 28 to May 20, 2022 in 190 sample schools all over the country. A total of 42 students shall be randomly selected per school by PISA international contractors and BEA for said assessment. The specific schedule for each school will be announced in a separate memorandum.
