Validity, Expiration, and Renewal of PNPKI **Digital Certificates**

PNPKI digital certificates are valid up to two years.

Toward the expiry of the certificate, DICT will send an email notifying you that your digital certificate will expire soon.

The email will contain further instructions on how you can "renew" your PNPKI digital certificate.

Strictly speaking, a digital certificate cannot be "renewed," because once the old digital certificate is expired, you must request for a new one.















Install and Use Your PNPKI Digital Signature

Once you receive your PNPKI credentials from DICT, you can use them to install your digital signature and attach it to your documents.

Lost/Compromised Private Key or Forgotten Passphrase

Your digital certificate is a public document; it is, however, unique to you.

NEVER LOSE OR FORGET IT OR THE PRIVATE KEY AND THE PASSPHRASE ASSOCIATED WITH YOUR DIGITAL CERTIFICATE.

If your private key is lost or compromised, or the passphrase to use it is forgotten, you must request to have your existing digital certificate revoked and request for a new one.

What happens to my **PNPKI if I leave DepEd?**

If you will be separated from government service or your employment with DepEd will be terminated, you must send a request to DICT to have your PNPKI digital certificate revoked.

Fill out the Digital Certificate Revocation Form and email the signed copy to your designated Regional PNPKI team. You must complete the process yourself before your last day of service.

The BHROD-Personnel Division (for CO personnel) or the Human Resource/Personnel Office/Unit (for RO/SDO personnel) reserves the exclusive right to request DICT to revoke the PNPKI credentials of an employee whose employment with DepEd is terminated should if he or she fails to process the request for revocation.
