- 1. The participants are pupils, students, teachers, school heads, school and district personnel and SPA students who have been chosen from a series of competitions starting from the school and district levels.
- 2. The 2^{nd} Regional Festival of Songs, Music, and Dances per Regional Memorandum no. 04 s. 2014 dated January 6, 2014 will be staged at the Iriga City Colosseum on February 8, 2014 at 10:00 in the morning.
- 3. This year's theme: "Ang Kabataan Tungo sa Kinabukasan ng Musika at Sining", is geared towards the accomplishment of the following objectives:
 - a) showcase the artistic potential and hone grown talents of learners, teachers and stakeholders;
 - b) preserve for posterity the songs, music and dances of the people;
 - c) strengthen linkages which the local government unit as indispensable partners of education; and
 - d) provide opportunities for cultural exchange in the enhancement of cultural education among participants.
- 4. Delegations will be billeted at Iriga Central School on Feb. 7-9, 2014. The general rehearsals and actual presentation will be on Feb. 7 and 8 respectively. - 5. The delegation head shall submit the synopsis of the presentation and the list of performers to the Division Coordinator for Music and Arts, Mrs. Sarah S. Chiong, Head Teacher III, MAPEH on or before January 28, 2014 for submissions to the Regional Office.
- 6. Final rehearsals of the participants will be on Jan. 24-25, 2014, 8:00 AM at Division Office Terrace.
- 7. Travelling and other operational expenses to be incurred by the participants during the final rehearsals and the actual travel to Iriga City are changeable against respective SEF, MOOE, PTA, cultural or other sources of fund subject the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
