DIVISION INSTRUCTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR SCIENCE TEACHERS (DIDPST) (SECONDARY)

To: Secondary School Heads

- In keeping with the Division Targets on the Improvement of Students' Performance Level in Science and Technology a Division Instructional Development Program for Science Teachers will be conducted one (1) Saturday every month starting September 27, 2014 until February 21, 2015. The 1st DIDPST for this SY will be conducted at Bato Rural Development High School, Bato, Catanduanes on September 27, 2014 starting at 8 A.M.
- 2. This DIDPST aims to enhance the secondary science teachers' content knowledge, skill and will to develop the scientific literacy among students that will prepare them to be informed and participative citizen who are able to make judgment and decisions regarding application of scientific knowledge that may have social, health or environmental impacts.
- Expected participants to this training are the secondary science teachers of this Division.
 Participants are expected to bring at least one (1) laptop/school, Teachers Guide,
 Learners Module, Wifi (if available) and other references.
- 4. One (1) day service credit will be granted to each participant for every attendance to a DIDPST Session.
- 5. A registration of two hundred pesos (Php 200.00) per participant shall be deducted from the school MOOE fund of each school from the Nationalized High School. Participants from implementing units are expected to pay the registration fee to the cashier's office chargeable to their respective school MOOE.
- 6. Travel and other incidental expenses relative to this training shall be charged against school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
